## 1 Scope

This policy applies to SQM Potasio SpA and SQM Australia Pty Ltd and its controlled subsidiaries (SQMi), also known as SQM International Lithium, the international lithium arm of the SQM group (SQM:NYSE). This Policy addresses all our areas of operational control and will be pursued in areas of influence.

## 2 Aim

At SQMi we want to empower the world to embrace clean energy technologies. Our lithium products are an essential component of batteries enabling effective storage of renewable energy. However, activities along the value chain generate greenhouse gas emissions. Reducing emissions is key to contributing to environmental stewardship and the world of the future. This policy forms a key component of our commitment to manage climate change.

## 3 Commitments

We commit to:

- Identify and measure our greenhouse gas emissions (GGE).
- Develop a plan which aims to reduce GGE to achieve a net zero target by 2050 or better.
- Identify climate-related physical and transitional risks, opportunities and mitigation measures.
- Aim to increase our reliance on renewable energies.
- Monitor and report progress on the above commitments.
